## S11 (IOLS) INTRODUCTION TO OUTDOOR LEADER SKILLS

Working as Patrols, this hands-on course provides adult leaders the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. Upon completion, leaders should feel comfortable teaching Scouts the basic out-door skills required to obtain the First Class rank. This course is required of all direct contact leaders registered in Boy Scout Troops and Varsity Scout Teams, in order to wear the "Trained" patch.

## C21 (BALOO) BASIC ADULT LEADER OUTDOOR ORIENTATION

This training introduces parents and leaders to the skills needed to plan and conduct outdoor Pack activities, particularly camping. A day of fun and learning prepares Pack leaders to plan and carry out "entry-level" outdoor experiences.

Ask a boy why he wants to be a Cub Scout, and nine times out of ten he'll answer "to go camping." Cub Scouting has

designed Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO) training, so boys, along with their parents or another adult, can participate in a successful overnight camping experience.

# S24 SCOUTMASTER & ASSISTANT SPECIFIC TRAINING

This training Concentrates on the operations of a Troop. Learn about the "how-to" of program planning, the Patrol method, Troop organization, and advancements.

#### C33 (OWL) OUTDOOR LEADER SKILLS FOR WEBELOS LEADERS

The course was designed specifically for Webelos Den Leaders and their assistants, Outdoor skills are taught through demonstration and hands-on practice. It also prepares the leader to conduct Webelos overnight camping with the scouts and parents of the Den. In addition to covering basic camping skills, this training features planning camp-outs, finding resources, and the skills needed to complete many of the Webelos tivity badges.

This weekend of training will also include CPR, Cub Scout Shooting Sports, LNT, ILST.

The equipment you will need to bring is whatever you would usually take camping. You will be able to take you vehicles to your campsite to drop off equipment.

At the end of the training you will receive a certificate and patch for this training.

This will also complete one of the requirements to be a Trained Leader.
