Our national forests and parks along with our state parks all ask that our Scout units be familiar with and practice "Leave No Trace thinking" as we enjoy outdoor Scouting. Our Scouting camp properties, too!

A **Leave No Trace Trainer** is exactly the right person to help our active and adventurous units understand how to care for the local areas used for outdoor Scouting **and** for the mountains, deserts, rivers, and other exciting places they love to visit for high adventure.

The Leave No Trace Trainer course introduces the role that Leave No Trace plays in the advancement and awards for our Scouts at all program levels (Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, and Venturing). Impact issues related to large council/district programs are also discussed.

"Patrol box" or "tailgate" style camping and cooking will be part of the course. The course will provide group camping equipment (dining fly, cooking gear, etc.). You are asked to bring the personal gear you like to use whenever your unit enjoys this style of camping.

The course will start with indoor sessions at
7:00pm on Friday, October 6.

You will probably want to arrive a little earlier to set up your personal camping gear before dark. Food will be provided from cracker barrel on Friday evening through Sunday lunch.

The course will conclude by **3:00 pm on Sunday.**

The **\$35 fee** covers all food and Leave No Trace materials. Register for the course **by September 29** using the website for the Northeast Training Expo:
