

WILDERNESS FIRST + AID

Priority Medical Training (PMT) is offering to the BSA the Wilderness First Aid course for scouts and scouters. Course Cost is 95.00 which is a 2 day Course and 25.00 for an AHA CPR certification

WFA is the assessment of and treatment given to an ill person in a remote environment where rapid or immediate transport is not readily available. PMT offers the course to any scout or scouter 13 years of age and older. PMT's is a secondary education school and staffed with instructors from a variety of backgrounds including Paramedic, Advanced EMT and Wilderness Instructors.

The Course covers a variety of modules to include:

- Patient assessment in the field
- Field triage
- Assessment and treatment by body system
- Common wilderness injuries and illnesses
- Search and Rescue

Course Information:

- Courses are taught by qualified instructors and registered scouting members.
- Course location can be anywhere.
- Cost is again 95.00 for the course and includes books 25.00 for CPR
- **Note: We ask to have a minimum of 10 persons.**
